Dear Parent/Guardian:

Last spring, your child took the Smarter Balanced Summative Assessments for English language arts/literacy and mathematics. Students in grades 5 and 8 also took the California Science Test.

These tests can be combined with other measures like report card grades, classroom work, and teacher observations to give families and teachers a complete picture of each child's learning. You can use these results to identify where your child is doing well and where they might need more support. It is important to know that summative test results are not used to determine whether a student moves to the next grade.

You can access your child's score report through the PowerSchool parent portal.

Your child's score report will give you information about how well he/she met the grade level expectations and where they are doing well or need more support in each subject. This is helpful information to discuss with your child's teacher to understand how they can be better supported in the classroom and how you can support learning at home.
