Last week we shared information about changes in masking guidelines for students and the use of Rapid Test Kits. Today, we have some updates we'd like to share about the student use of the Rapid Test Kits.

The District has finalized the plan of use for the test kits. Here are how the tests will be used:

COVID Symptoms

- If your student is showing COVID symptoms at school, they will be escorted to the Wellness Room and you will be contacted for pickup.
- Once you arrive at the school's Wellness Room for pickup, we will issue you a sealed Antigen Rapid Test kit containing two rapid tests and instructions on how to administer the test. Once you are safely home with your student you may administer the rapid test.

COVID Exposure

- If it is determined that your student was exposed to a person who tested positive for COVID, the school will contact you to pick up your student.
- Once you arrive at the school for pickup, we will issue a sealed Antigen Rapid Test kit containing two rapid tests and instructions on how to administer the test. Once you are safely home with your student you may administer the rapid test.

If you would like the school site to administer the Antigen Rapid Test, you must sign the parent permission slip upon arrival at the school's Wellness Room.
