7th grade classes have been learning the functions of mechanisms.

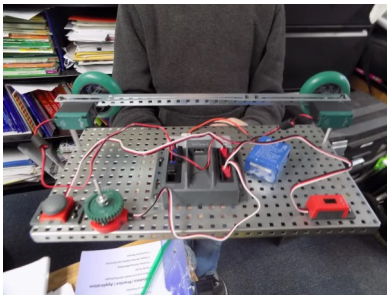
Mr. Sprague

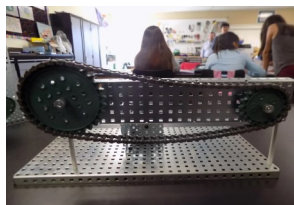


What's Happening Now?

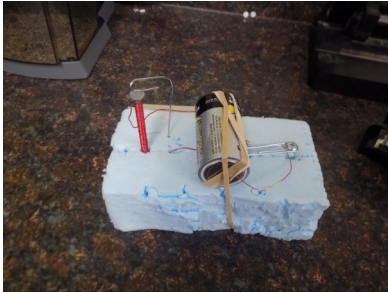
